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The Importance of Educator Input in Student Outcomes

Studies show when both parents *and* teachers weigh in about children's behavior in the diagnosis of ADHD:

More than twice as many children with ADHD showed lessened symptoms.

Earlier treatment results in better outcomes years later, including: better academic results, less special class placement, lower rates of grade repetition and school drop-outs, and lower rates of substance abuse.

How Does CHADIS Work?

CHADIS uses online questionnaires to help educators and families communicate with clinicians about students. All answers are confidentially delivered directly to the clinician, in compliance with FERPA. Having both classroom and home feedback is imperative to helping children thrive.

Access

Teachers receive an invitation via email from parents or clinicians to complete a questionnaire on behalf of a student. Questionnaires can be completed quickly online and results are sent directly back to the child's provider.

Safety and Security

CHADIS is completely secure and HIPAA and FERPA compliant. Parents can sign an electronic consent form in CHADIS allowing teachers permission to provide feedback on their child .

What to Expect

Share feedback in regard to a student's behavior in the educational setting.

Collaborate on student improvements; report on how efficient the interventions are in improving a student's classroom performance.

Track the progress of a student's social skills in the classroom.
